The Parish Pastoral Council

The present Pastoral Council was set up in September 2004 last. A process under the guidance of Sr. Mairead O'Sullivan was introduced at that time so that the members would get to know each other and that each one would be able to identify and use their talents to serve the Parish of Ballincollig.

Also during this process we had many meetings before the election of officers to the Pastoral Council in January 2005.

The Pastoral Council is broken into the following groups, which enables people to be creative and giving of their time to serve the various needs of the Parish. Ministers of the Eucharist, Ministers of the Word, Eucharistic Group, Liturgy Group, Sacristan, Choir Group, Visitation Group (nursing homes and the sick), Bible Study Group, New Parishioner Welcome Group, Maintenance Group, Men's Group, First Friday Adoration Group, Altar Society, Family Mass and Children's Liturgy, Parish Newsletter, Corpus Christi Procession, Youth Group, Preparation for Baptism both adult and infant.

During the year so far we have set up a Parish Office. Suggestion boxes have been placed in both Churches.

For the remainder of the year much attention will be focused on the document "Pilgrim Steps" which was launched last Friday 10th June.

For a Parish Pastoral Council to survive and be vibrant it needs the support of the Parish in the form of Prayer, participation and suggestions.

SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Romuald 19-June-2005

St. Romuald was born at Ravenna about the year 956. In spite of an infinite desire for virtue and sanctity, his early life was wasted in the service of the world and its pleasures. Then one day, obliged by his father, Sergius, to be present at a duel fought by him, he beheld him slay his adversary. The crime made such an impression upon him that he determined to expiate it for forty days, as though it were entirely his own. For this purpose he retired to a Benedictine monastery of St. Apollinare, near Ravenna, where he became Abbot. After founding several monasteries, he laid the foundations of the austere Order of Camaldoli in Tuscany. Like all the saints, he fought a lifelong battle against the assaults of devils and men. In the beginning of his spiritual life he was strongly assailed by numerous temptations, which he conquered by vigilance and prayer. More than one attempt was made on his life, but Divine Providence enabled him to escape from the danger. Like many servants of God, he also became the victim of calumny, which he bore in patience and silence. In his old age, he increased his austerities instead of diminishing them. After a long life of merit, he died in the monastery of Castro, which he founded in Marquisate of Ancona. His death occurred on June 19, about the year 1027.
