Invitation to "Come walk with Me" in Ballincollig on Saturday 13th June after 6 pm Mass

In today's Gospel Jesus tells his disciples, 'know that I am with you always, yes to the end of time'. As his followers, he is also always with us. In a special way he is with us in the Eucharist. On Saturday 13th June our Parish community will give public witness to our faith when we join together for our Eucharistic Procession on the streets of Ballincollig.

As we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Trinity today, it is a reminder that at the conclusion of each Eucharistic celebration we are sent out, in the name of the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit, to love and serve the Lord and one another. "The power of the Eucharistic sacrament goes beyond the walls of our Church" (Pope Benedict). 
Knock Summer Youth Festival 2009. "You are the light of the world" July 23rd to 26th, 2009.
