Lenten Retreat

This year we have a three day Parish retreat for Lent in the Church of Christ Our Light, starting on Sunday evening March 20th. Lent is a good time to withdraw a little from our normal day-to-day worries and concerns, to reflect on the meaning and purpose of our lives and to take stock of where we are in life. Our short retreat affords an opportunity of doing this, and of being nourished by the Word of Life and of allowing God to renew our faith, our hope and our love. The theme of our retreat will be the Eucharist and it will be conducted by Fr Finbarr O'Halloran of the Blessed Sacrament Fathers. The Lenten retreat will help us to prepare for Holy Week and Easter, and on a more long term basis to begin our preparation for the International Eucharistic Congress in Dublin in June of next year. One of the aims of the Congress is to promote an awareness of the central place of the Eucharist in the life and mission of the Catholic Community.

God's love for us is poured out in the sacrament of the Eucharist, where Christ is truly present, giving us life and healing. "The Holy Eucharist is the perfect expression of the love of Jesus Christ for man" (Saint Peter Julian Eymund). When we come together for Mass we gather as God's people, present together before him. We listen together as his Word of Life is proclaimed in the Mass readings and we are nourished by his body and blood in the sacrament of Holy Communion. We give thanks and as we leave we are sent out by the Lord to live our lives in joy and love.

The retreat will begin at 7.30 pm each evening from Sunday to Tuesday with morning Mass on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. There will be an extra Mass at 7.00 am in Christ Our Light on these mornings to facilitate those unable to attend the 8.30 am or 9.30 am Masses.

We pray that our 2011 Lenten retreat will help us to learn about and reflect on the mystery of God's love for us, and to experience his care for us as we are renewed by the redeeming love of Christ. We pray that the retreat will increase our faithfulness to Our Lord's gift of himself to us in the Mass and deepen our appreciation of our faith.

The retreat will be facilitated by Fr. Finbarr O'Halloran Blessed Sacrament Fathers.

THE SUNDAY READINGS

First Reading: Genesis 2:7-9; 3:1-7 The Lord God created Adam and Eve and set them in the Garden of Eden. They had all they needed, but the serpent tempted them, and they disobeyed God's command.

Second Reading: Romans 5:12-19 Just as through Adam's disobedience all became sinners, through Christ's obedience all shall become just.

Gospel: Matthew 4:1-11

Following his baptism in the Jordan River, Jesus went out to the desert to pray and understand God's will. He was alone in the desert for 40 days and nights. Satan waited until Jesus emerged from the desert before tempting Jesus to use his powers. Of course, Jesus was hungry after fasting for 40 days, so the devil tempted him first with food.
