# 16th Ordinary General Assembly of the Synod of Bishops

In October 2021, Pope Francis announced a Universal Synod on the theme 'For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission.' Following two years of preparation, listening and

dialogue at diocesan, continental and universal level, 365 people gathered in Rome to participate in its first assembly, which took place from 4 - 29 October. Bishop Brendan Leahy and Bishop Alan McGuckian were the two bishop nominees of the Irish Catholic Bishops' Conference.
